For the last 29 years, our Congregation along with many concerned citizens, churches, hospital personnel, police and fire departments and organizations from all over Delaware County, come together to reach out to the needy, elderly, disabled, homeless, sick, and home bound. Under normal circumstances, hundreds of volunteers were coming to our hall to prepare and deliver thousands of meals in Delaware County. Due to COVID still being on our radar, we had to become more creative. We are reaching out to the churches and organizations in the Delaware County area to see if they can help provide a \$25.00 grocery card and/or a frozen turkey or a Thanksgiving meal. We have clients in every town in Delaware County and many are elderly and home bound.

Last year, because of everyone's generosity, we were able to provide over 350, \$25.00 grocery or diner cards, deliver 100 frozen turkeys to the larger families and deliver over a 100 meals, from a local diner, to those who are severely handicapped. Many agencies such as Hospice, Schoolhouse Senior Center, Senior Community Services, Senior Victims of Crime, Upland Food Bank, just to name a few, refer individuals and families to us for help. It has always been our goal to never turn anyone away. That is why we are reaching out for help.

Here are some of the ways you can help:

2. Help us make phone calls to clients and /or help address envelopes for mailing.
3. Help deliver frozen turkeys to clients Saturday, November 19th starting at 9 am (Sat before Thanksgiving)
4. Meet at the First Presbyterian Church at 11 am and deliver meals from Folcroft diner to our clients on Thanksgiving Day.
5. Provide Thanksgiving meals to a client or a family.

We are so grateful for the community's help so we all can join together to reach out to our neighbors in need. Many of our Elderly feel isolated and this would be an awesome way to show them we care.
